Nominee qualifications

These individuals should show the promise of and a commitment to impacting their publication and industry in a positive manner through professional achievement. Nominees must also show they not only perform their jobs to a high standard, but they also have a commitment to furthering their knowledge and abilities. Nominees must actively work in the free paper industry for a member of MFCP and are required to have been employed for six months.

Recognition program

The Most Valued Professional award recipients will be recognized in PaperClips, the official newsletter of MFCP, as well as participate in the annual MFCP Conference and Trade Show. MVP award winners receive free registration and hotel accommodations at the Conference as part of their award.
